Swan Hill Art Gallery redevelopment community information session

A community information session is being held to update residents on the Swan Hill Regional Art Gallery redevelopment.

Art Gallery Director, Ian Tully said preliminary concept designs had been completed and that he was looking forward to joining the architects, to provide a community update.

“We are looking forward to updating the community on the progress of this redevelopment.

“Our architects have listened to all the feedback and created two concepts that are reflective of your views.

“They have also ensured that the building’s footprint would not create an impact on residents with properties that neighbour the gallery site,” Mr Tully said.

A community information session will be held on Thursday, 27 July from 4-6pm at the Swan Hill Regional Art Gallery.

“Architects will be in attendance and will present two concept designs.

“I encourage anyone interested in learning more about the development, to come along and hear from our architects,” Mr Tully said.
